DEMOKRACIA

Në vitin 2025, Festivali Ndërkombëtar i Posterit “Prishtina” shndërrohet në një platformë për reflektim vizual mbi një nga idealet më të qëndrueshme dhe më të debatuar të botës: Demokracinë. Këtë edicion, festivali fton dizajnerë, artistë, studentë dhe aktivistë nga e gjithë bota të eksplorojnë se si demokracia jetohet, testohet dhe transformohet në shoqëritë e sotme — veçanërisht në rajonin e Ballkanit Perëndimor, ku historitë e konfliktit, tranzicionit dhe aspiratave europiane vazhdojnë të formësojnë të tashmen.

Këtu, demokracia nuk trajtohet si një model i fiksuar apo formulë institucionale, por si një praktikë e gjallë dhe në zhvillim — një dialog i vazhdueshëm midis pushtetit dhe njerëzve, individit dhe kolektivit, kujtesës dhe imagjinatës. Përmes gjuhës së komunikimit vizual, festivali ngre pyetjet: Çfarë do të thotë demokracia në vitin 2025? Si përjetohet, sfidohet dhe riformësohet ajo nga ata që përballen me ndryshimet shoqërore, migracionin, manipulimin mediatic dhe pasigurinë politike?

Në Kosovë, Maqedoninë e Veriut dhe Shqipëri, demokracia është njëkohësisht e brishtë dhe e qëndrueshme. Ajo ekziston në hapësirat mes zgjedhjeve dhe protestave, mes zërave të dëgjuar dhe të heshtur. Posterat e paraqitur në “Prishtina 2025” i japin formë këtyre kontradiktave — duke festuar pjesëmarrjen ndërsa përballen me zhgënjimin, duke ekspozuar korrupsionin ndërkohë që imagjinojnë reformën, duke vajtuar humbjet ndërsa mbjellin shpresën. Së bashku, ata ndërtojnë një portret kolektiv të një rajoni në dialog me vetveten dhe me botën.

Festivali thekson gjashtë tema qendrore që udhëheqin këtë eksplorim:

Pjesëmarrja – e drejta e votës, angazhimi qytetar dhe aktivizmi në bazë.

Media – liria e fjalës, dezinformimi dhe gazetaria e pavarur.

Korrupsioni – besimi institucional, transparenca dhe reforma.

Përkatësia – kufijtë, migracioni, identiteti dhe përfshirja.

Kujtesa – historia kolektive, shërimi dhe zërat ndërbrezorë.

Shpresa – lëvizjet rinore, imagjinata dhe vizionet për të ardhmen.

Në një epokë kur vlerat demokratike janë nën presion në mbarë botën, Ballkani Perëndimor ofron një pasqyrë dhe një mesazh. Ai na kujton se demokracia nuk është një projekt i përfunduar, por një negociim i vazhdueshëm — një ekuilibër i brishtë që mbahet gjallë nga pjesëmarrja, krijimtaria dhe mendimi kritik.

“Prishtina 2025” e pozicionon posteri si dëshmitar dhe armë njëkohësisht — një medium demokratik që kap pulsën e një brezi duke ndezur njëkohësisht debatin që demokracia kërkon. Këtu, dizajni vizual shndërrohet në një gjuhë publike të mosbindjes, solidaritetit dhe rigjallërimit — duke e kthyer aktin krijues në një akt qytetar.

Përmes këtij festivali, arti dhe dizajni e rimarrin rolin e tyre qytetar: të pyesin, të kujtojnë dhe të imagjinojnë. Në çdo poster fshihet mundësia e një të ardhmeje ndryshe — e cila nuk vizatohet nga institucionet, por nga vetë njerëzit.

DEMOCRACY

In 2025, the International Poster Festival “Prishtina” becomes a platform for visual reflection on one of the world’s most enduring and contested ideals: Democracy. This edition invites designers, artists, students, and activists from across the globe to explore how democracy is lived, tested, and transformed in today’s societies—particularly within the Western Balkans, where histories of conflict, transition, and aspiration continue to shape the present.

Democracy here is not treated as a fixed model or institutional formula, but as a living, evolving practice—a dialogue between power and people, individual and collective, memory and imagination. Through the lens of visual communication, the festival asks: What does democracy mean in 2025? How is it experienced, challenged, and redefined by those navigating social change, migration, media manipulation, and political uncertainty?

In Kosovo, North Macedonia, and Albania, democracy is both fragile and resilient. It exists in the spaces between elections and protests, between voices amplified and silenced. The posters featured in “Prishtina 2025” give form to these contradictions—celebrating participation while confronting disillusionment, exposing corruption while envisioning reform, mourning losses while cultivating hope. Together, they form a collective portrait of a region in conversation with itself and with the wider world.

The festival foregrounds six thematic threads that guide this exploration:

Participation – voting rights, civic engagement, and grassroots activism.

Media – freedom of speech, disinformation, and independent journalism.

Corruption – institutional trust, transparency, and reform.

Belonging – borders, migration, identity, and inclusion.

Memory – collective history, healing, and intergenerational voices.

Hope – youth movements, imagination, and visions for the future.

In an era when democratic values are under pressure globally, the Western Balkans offer both a mirror and a message. They remind us that democracy is not a finished project but a continuous negotiation—a fragile balance sustained by participation, creativity, and critical thought.

“Prishtina 2025” positions the poster as both witness and weapon—a democratic medium capable of capturing the pulse of a generation while igniting the discourse that democracy demands. Here, visual design becomes a public language of dissent, solidarity, and renewal, transforming the act of creation into an act of citizenship.

Through this festival, art and design reclaim their civic role: to question, to remember, and to imagine. In every poster lies the possibility of a different future—one drawn not by institutions but by people.

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Elizabeth Resnick, a distinguished Professor Emerita and former chair of Graphic Design at Massachusetts College of Art and Design, Boston, is a globally recognized design curator. She has organized seven comprehensive exhibitions, including the current traveling exhibition Women's Rights Are Human Rights: International Posters on Gender-based Inequality, Violence and Discrimination. Her posters have been featured in prestigious international events such as the Mexican, Bolivian, Warsaw Biennials and numerous invitational exhibitions. Her publications, including the forthcoming Women Graphic Designers, Bloomsbury Visual Arts (2025), The Social Design Reader, Bloomsbury Visual Arts (2019), Developing Citizen Designers, Bloomsbury Academic (2016), Design for Communication: Conceptual Graphic Design Basics, John Wiley & Sons Publishers (2003) and Graphic Design: A Problem-Solving Approach to Visual Communication, Prentice-Hall Publishers (1984), have further solidified her status as a thought leader in the field.

Iva Babaja, mag.doc.art., was born in Zagreb. She received her Master's degree in 1996 at the prestigious University of Applied Arts in Vienna. She started her career as a freelance designer, and continued in the advertising industry, where she achieved many successes and was chosen as one of the best creative directors in the region. In 2017, she founded Babaja Branding & Design Consultancy d.o.o. Along her professional work, she is a dedicated design educator and is currently an Assistant Professor at the Algebra University in Zagreb, where she lectures the Goldsmiths University of London dual degree programme and several other courses. In addition to her professional work, Iva has from the very beginning also been engaged in volunteer work and spent 10 years on the Board of the International Council of Design ICoD, which represents about 200 organizations in about 70 countries. Through her engagement, she systematically worked on the promotion of the design profession, international regulations for tenders and professional ethics and practice, wrote numerous international regulations and implemented numerous reforms, the most significant of which is the expansion of the Council's activities from graphic design into a multidisciplinary area. Thanks to her work, in 2016 she was elected the first female President in the institution's 50-year history. Iva's works have been published in numerous publications in Croatia and around the world, and she is a frequent guest lecturer at conferences and professional gatherings and a member of numerous international juries. Along with numerous other awards, in 2018 she was honoured with the Order of Danica Hrvatska by the President of Croatia for her contribution to the promotion of Croatian culture and design. Iva is a member of the Croatian Design Society (HDD) and ULUPUH and is a lifetime honorary member of the ICoD.

Viviane's work uses perspective into a variety of themes in a way that is accessible to a wide range of audiences. With a career spanning over three decades, Canniffe has held leadership and teaching positions at renowned institutions such as the Maryland Institute College of Art, Minneapolis College of Art and Design, Ringling College of Art and Design, and currently serves as Faculty at Iowa State University's College of Design. He is the co-founder of PIECE Studio, a collaborative social justice design initiative, and an advisor to Project M, an international network promoting design for social good. His projects and lectures around the world focus on socially responsive design, community engagement, and innovation in design education. Canniffe's work has been featured in major design exhibitions and publications across the U.S., Europe, Asia, and South America, earning him numerous international awards and recognition for his contributions to design and education.

He mainly works for cultural institutions such as museums and public clients. More and more he dedicates himself to teaching. He is currently teaching graphic design, media design and poster design at the Designschule Schwerin, the Freie Schule für Gestaltung Hamburg, the htk academy, the DIPLOMA Hochschule and SRH - The Mobile University. In addition, he gives international talks and workshops on social poster design. He has already been a speaker in Türkiye, the U.S., China, Pakistan, Singapore, Canada and Egypt. His renowned posters are also exhibited worldwide. In almost 70 exhibitions in more than 20 countries, his works have impressed with their intelligence and humour. 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Edib Agagjyshi (born on January 24, 1977, in Peja, Kosovo) is a graphic designer, visual artist, and lecturer with an extensive career in the field of art and visual communication. He earned his Bachelor's and Master's degrees from the Faculty of Arts, University of Prishtina, and is currently pursuing a PhD at the International University of Novi Pazar. Since the early 1990s, Agagjyshi has been engaged in media, editorial design, and cultural projects. He co-founded the youth magazine Tung and collaborated closely with Studio Nekra. Over the years, he has worked as a designer for several newspapers and institutions, including Koha Ditore, Dukagjini Publishing House, the Academy of Sciences and Arts of Kosovo, and the OSCE Mission in Kosovo. On the international stage, he has served as a Graphic Design Specialist for the United Nations (UNDP, UNOPS), contributing to electoral and communication programs in Libya, Somalia, Sierra Leone, Nauru, and currently with the UNDP Pacific Electoral Program (PEP). In addition to his graphic design work, Agagjyshi is active in theatre and film set and costume design, as well as illustration, painting, and cartoon art. His works have been featured in numerous exhibitions and projects across Kosovo, North Macedonia, Albania, and Turkey.

Ermir Hoxha (b. 1979, Tirana) is an Albanian art historian, researcher, and lecturer. He holds degrees from the Academy of Arts (Painting, 2003), the University of Bologna (Contemporary Art History, 2007), and the University of Tirana (Geography, 2008). In 2015, he earned his PhD in Historical Sciences with a dissertation titled "Art in Albania 1945–1990", and has held the academic title of Associate Professor since 2025. He currently serves as Head of the Department of Applied Arts and lectures on the History of Albanian Art at the University of Arts, Tirana. Hoxha is the author of several notable books on Albanian art and culture, including "The History of Albanian Photography, 1965–2000" (2022), "The History of Art in Albania – From Prehistory to the 20th Century" (2020), and "Socialist Realism in the Albanian Style" (2023). His work focuses on the evolution of Albanian visual culture from socialist realism to contemporary art.

The artist works in the fields of poster and applied graphics, and is the co-founder of Poster House Graphic Design Studio. The artist has participated in a number of poster forums, among which: NO WAR (exhibition), Warsaw (Poland); THE WORLD AFTER (album); ANTI-NOVEL Coronavirus 100 posters (exhibition), Wenzhou, Zhejiang province (China); From The Trenches. One day less, one more design (exhibition), Barcelona (Spain); International Biennial of Theatre Poster – Rzeszów (Poland); VIDAC (Republic of Korea); Golden Bee Global Biennale of Graphic Design – Moscow (Russia); International Triennial of Stage Poster – Sofia (Bulgaria); and the international poster biennials in Mexico, Bolivia, Tmava, etc. Lyuba Tomova is the recipient of various graphic design awards, to name a few: Sofia Grand Prix, Golden Poster statuette from the X International Triennial of Stage Poster – Sofia, First Prize from "For a Sustainable World" anonymous national contest for poster – Sofia (Rio+20 initiative), Special Award from the V International Triennial of Stage Poster – Sofia, First Prize for poster from the XVIII International Biennial of Humour and Satire in the Arts – Gabrovo. She has realised 5 solo exhibitions under the motto "Asocial about Social" in the Bulgarian cities of Ruse, Dobrich, Dimitrovgrad and Varna. The artist is a member of New Vision International Group, the Graphic Design Section of the Union of Bulgarian Artists, and the Chamber of Designers in Bulgaria.



Wheels & Waves is the brainchild of Rikke Hansen but much it is much more than her. You could say it is a new way of organizing a collective of designers and educators who have committed themselves to seeing communication and development of the coming generations as two sides of the same coin.

Working together with sound designers, script writers and programmers linking the right people to the right project. We worked with Danish Music Award winners Hudna on their highly acclaimed first album release.

We work on exhibition projects, and on devolping project related to ideageneration and graphic design.

Rikke is Vice Chairman at The Danish Book Craft Society. Board Member, Bienal del Cartel Bolivia BICeBé. Advisory Board Member, ODC - Odisha Design Council.

She has been exhibiting and giving lectures & workshops internationally in Asia, the Middle East, South and North America.
